Attract and retain talent

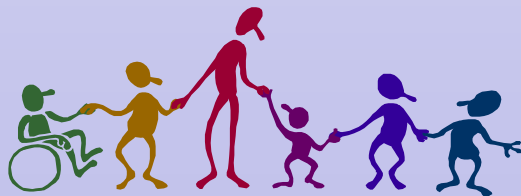
Increase productivity by reducing the hours wasted on dealing with internal disputes
